The society manages the allotment sites off Ollersett Avenue and in Hague Bar and maintains a waiting list for available plots on either site. Allotment plots will be offered fairly, when they become available. The society is committed to raising awareness of the benefits of growing and eating fresh vegetables.

Membership of the society is open to any local resident who is interested in gardening, even if they do not wish to rent an allotment when they become available.

The society participates in the National Allotment Society seed scheme to enable members to buy seeds more cheaply than from a garden centre or seed supplier.

Benefits of membership include the opportunity to network with other gardeners, participate in the seed purchasing scheme, receive information about events and resources supportive of gardening, promote gardening as a healthy living activity and rent an allotment on either site.
